

1. The controller of personal data of persons applying for the internship taking place within the workshops "KIDS KINO.LAB" 2020/2021 (hereinafter: Workshops) and persons with whom an internship agreement will be concluded (hereinafter: Interns) is the Stowarzyszenie NOWE HORYZONTY with its registered office in Warsaw, at ul. Ludwika Zamenhofa 1, 00-153 Warsaw (Poland), entered into the register of associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations and self – dependent public healthcare institutions and the register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number 000016200, NIP (VAT EU) number PL 525-22-71-014, REGON number 015503904 (hereinafter: SNH).
2. Applicants and Interns may contact SNH by sending a letter to the SNH registered office or by e-mail to the following address: katarzyna.janiak@nowehoryzonty.pl
3. Personal data of persons submitting applications and Interns will be processed:
 - 1) pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 point a) of the GDPR, i.e. on the basis of the consent of the person making the application, in order to accept and consider the application;
 - 2) pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 point b) of the GDPR in order to conclude and implement an internship agreement, as a result of qualifying a person for the internship;
 - 3) pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 point f) of the GDPR, i.e. in order to implement the legitimate interest of SNH in the form of publishing personal data of the applicant and Intern, including his/her image, on the website www.kidskinolab.pl and in books, albums, press and other publishing publications, posters, leaflets, brochures, as part of outdoor, open and private exhibitions, as part of audiovisual and multimedia works, including in electronic form on SNH social profiles, for the purposes of promoting or advertising SNH in connection with the consent granted by the Intern to distribute the image.
4. Personal data of persons submitting applications or Interns will be made available or entrusted to entities cooperating with SNH in the implementation of the Workshops, as well as entities providing financial and accounting, hosting, IT, legal, printing and marketing services. In particular, the personal data of the Interns will be made available to the co-organizers of the Workshops referred to in paragraph 13 below. The personal data of the Interns may also be made available to entities co-financing the Workshops.
5. Personal data will be stored by SNH:
 - 1) in the case referred to in paragraph 3 point 1) above - until the date of examination of the application and notification of the results of examination of the application, but not later than 7 days from the date of examination of the application;
 - 2) in the case referred to in paragraph 3 point 2) above - for the duration of the internship agreement, and then for the period until the expiry of the limitation period for claims that may arise from the internship agreement, determined in accordance with mandatory provisions of law;
 - 3) in the case referred to in paragraph 3 point 3) above - for the period of implementation of promotional activities by SNH, until the effective implementation of the objection raised to the processing of personal data or until the consent to distribute the image is withdrawn - whichever occurs first.
6. The person submitting the application and the Intern have the right to request access to personal data from SNH, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing.
7. With regard to personal data processed pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 point a) or b) of the GDPR, the person submitting the application and the Intern have the right to transfer data if these data are processed in an automated manner.
8. With regard to personal data processed pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 point f) of the GDPR, the Intern has the right to object to the processing of his personal data by SNH.
9. The person submitting the application and the Intern have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in connection with the processing of personal data by SNH.
10. The person submitting the application may withdraw the consent at any time through all available means of communication with SNH. Withdrawal of the consent granted does not affect the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
11. Providing the personal data indicated in the application form by the person submitting the application is voluntary, but it is necessary to accept and consider the application, conclude an internship agreement and to enable the Intern to participate in the Workshop.
12. As a rule, SNH will not transfer the personal data of persons submitting the application and Interns to third countries or international organizations within the meaning of the GDPR. However, SNH will provide information about the Workshops on SNH profiles on social networks: Facebook,

Instagram and YouTube. This means that personal data collected and stored on social networks Facebook, Instagram and YouTube are subject to the same rules as personal data processed by the owners of social networks Facebook, Instagram and YouTube. The above means that the personal data of the applicant and the Intern may be sent via the social networks Facebook, Instagram and YouTube outside the European Economic Area, in particular to the United States. These entities act as personal data controllers separate from SNH. Before using the social networks Facebook, Instagram and YouTube, the data subject should read:

SNH informs that with regard to the processing of personal data in connection with the co-organization of one of the Workshop sessions in the country of the seat of the SNH partner, the personal data of the Participants will be co-processed by SNH and the relevant partner (1. J.E.F Film Festival, Belgium, Antwerp (2000), Timmerwerfstraat 40, 2. Zlin Film Festival, Czech Rep., Zlín – Kudlov (760 01), Filmová 174) as joint controllers.

SNH informs that it has concluded a co-administration agreement with its partners, and the Intern may exercise his rights against the SNH or the co-controller by contacting the SNH in the manner indicated in paragraph 2 above. The content of the co-administration arrangements may be made available to Interns - for this purpose, please contact the SNH as indicated in paragraph 2 above.
